JACS JSON Export

Are you interested in making specialized charts of JACS results beyond those offered by JACS? This online help article centers on the new JACS JSON Export feature included in the ACEIT 8.2 JACS Application. Similar to the ACE JSON Export feature, the JACS JSON Export format provides results that can be imported into advanced charting tools, like Power BI. This tutorial shows step by step instructions on how to transition data from JACS to JSON and how to capitalize on the JSON tool to develop additional visualization charts and analysis.
