# ACEIT Highlight: User Conference Sessions

At the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual ACEIT User Conference, 23-25 January 2007 in Santa Barbara, CA, over a dozen different sessions will be presented including several by power ACEIT users in the field. Several of the presentations are highlighted for you here as a preview of what to expect at the conference.

#### > Leveraging ACEIT 7.0 New Features

Keeping up to date with the new features of a software release can be a challenge. This session will highlight several of the key features of the latest ACEIT release and provide users insight into how they can be applied in their work environment to enhance productivity, increase capability, or simplify an ACE model.

#### ACE Best Practices

Many ACE users have models that were originally built in an older version of ACEIT and modified over time as new modeling capability was needed. In these cases, ACE modelers may be using techniques that were state-of-the-art when the model was first built but can be dramatically improved by using current methods. In reviewing models via our help desk and consulting support we have identified several common practices where implementing a modern ACE Best Practice improves the performance and flexibility of the cost model. Knowledge of these practices is helpful for both new developers and experienced users. This session will cover the identification, impact, and implementation of ACE best practices.

#### > The Power of ACEIT Reporting

The final result of any cost estimation effort culminates with conveying the results to managers, reviewers, cost analysts, and other decision makers in a meaningful format. In this session, learn how to leverage the full capability of ACE, POST, and POST Doc to simplify the creation of various tabular and graphical reports and dramatically improve your productivity. Learn how to create full Basis of Estimate narrative reports, graphical depictions of your cost estimate, custom executive summaries, and automate both the creation and most importantly updating of PowerPoint presentations.

#### Building Inflation Tables & CER Libraries

A powerful new feature in ACEIT 7.0 is the Librarian. The Librarian is a powerful new utility to create, store and share custom inflation tables and CER (Cost Estimating Relationship) libraries. This session will demonstrate how a user can quickly build custom inflation tables or CER Libraries and directly implement them within an ACE session. This session will also demonstrate how users can leverage the Librarian to share CERs within their licensed site locations and rapidly implement alternative inflation indices.

#### > Applying Air Force Cost Analysis Agency Cost Risk Handbook in ACE

The Air Force Cost Analysis Agency (AFCAA) plans to publish a Cost Risk Handbook (CRH) to establish a standard for performing and reporting cost risk analysis. The guidance in the CRH was developed to be "tool independent". A primary author of this work will demonstrate how to implement the key steps outlined in the CRH within ACE. This is a great session for users interested in seeing how to implement cost risk analysis in ACEIT in general or interested in the USAF cost risk process.
