ACEIT Update: 2008 Inflation Indices Now Available

There is a new installation file available to install the ACEIT System Inflation Database to add the 2008 Inflation Indices. The Army, AF, Navy, USMC, MDA, SOCOM, NAVSEA and MARAD rates have been updated. Please download this file from the [Inflation Indices](#) page located in the Download section of the ACEIT.com website.

You will be required to login to the site as your DMS must be current to receive inflation updates. In general, out-year escalation has remained constant for the majority of the appropriations. Outlay rates/profiles have changed for several appropriations. The impact on users will be to generally see constant TY costs for your estimates.

This inflation indices update is for use with ACEIT 5.1 and above. The update includes the latest indices as of 22 February 2008.

ACEIT 7.1 - CRITICAL: ACE Known Issues

Problem: When working with sessions containing very large definitions, particularly definitions that contain pictures, ACE occasionally does not properly save definitions because available RAM is too low.

Action: This will be fixed in the patch which is scheduled to be release in July 2008.
